PillCam®Small Bowel Capsule Endoscopy

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To ensure the best results for your PillCam capsule endoscopy of the small bowel, follow your doctor's instructions carefully and completely.

Day Before Capsule Endoscopy

- 1. **Start the prescribed liquid diet in the morning and continue through out the day**. See liquid diet instructions form
- 2. **Do not eat or drink** except for necessary medication with a sip of water 10 hours before your capsule endoscopy.
- **3.** At 6:00 p.m. **mix 1 full dropper of Mylicon with Colyte (see prescription attached), and drink the prep.**

Day of Capsule Endoscopy

- 1. Do not take any medications 2 hours before having the procedure.
- 2. Do not apply body lotion or powder to your stomach area.
- 3. Wear loose fitting two-piece clothing. Your upper clothing should be opaque, not sheer.
- 4. If you take any medications you can start taking your medication(s) 4 hours after swallowing the capsule.

After Swallowing the PillCam SB Capsule

- (!) The capsule endoscopy procedure will last approximately 12 hours. Contact your doctor's office immediately if you suffer from any abdominal pain, nausea or vomiting during the procedure.
 - 1. You may drink colorless liquids starting 2 hours after swallowing the PillCam SB capsule.
 - 2. You may have a light lunch 4 hours after ingestion. After the procedure is completed, you may return to your normal diet.
 - 3. Check the blue flashing DataRecorder light every 15 minutes to be sure it is blinking twice per second. If it stops blinking or changes color orange/yellow, note the time and go back to your doctor's office.
 - 4. Use the Capsule Endoscopy Event Table, to note the time of any event such as eating, drinking or a change in your activity. Return the completed Event Form to your doctor at the time you return the equipment.
 - 5. Avoid strong electromagnetic fields such as MRI devices or hand radios after swallowing the capsule and until you pass it in a bowel movement.
 - 6. Do not disconnect the equipment or completely remove the belt at any time during the procedure.
 - 7. Treat the DataRecorder carefully. Avoid sudden movements and banging of the DataRecorder.
 - 8. Avoid direct exposure to bright sunlight.
